RULE REMINDERS:

NOVICE RIDERS may not compete in Canter/Lope classes, except for Specialty Classes.

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS CLASSES: Points in Championship classes will be scored on a graduated point system based on the number of riders in the class (points awarded for ribbon placings (1st – 6th), which is dependent on the number of riders in each class).

THERAPEUTIC RIDER CLASS: This class is open to differently-abled riders who are in a therapeutic riding program.

COACHING OR INSTRUCTING RIDERS FROM THE RAIL IS PROHIBITED

This rule has been adopted by Davis Ranch, Etowah Riding Club and McDowell Saddle Club for their Open Horse Shows.

- At our Open Horse Shows, verbally coaching, directing, training, shouting instructions and/or teaching a rider from the rail is prohibited, once the horse and rider have entered the arena for their class. The horse and rider are "on their own" to compete in their class without interruption from instructors, trainers, parents, friends and family.
- A rider is to take verbal instructions only from the judge, ring steward and/or announcer once they have entered the arena for their class.
- A rider will be **disqualified** if the show staff, announcer, ring steward or judge sees or hears such activities during an exhibitor's ride.
- General cheering, whooping and clapping to cheer riders on is allowed and encouraged!
